Dear Members & Friends of Zion,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

[Jesus said,] "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light." -Matthew 11:28-30

"In our sometimes stressful, anxious, overworked lives, Jesus's words in these verses offer such hope. Self-help approaches to dealing with stress usually require *more effort*: do this, try that, practice this, eat that. By contrast, Jesus calls us to come to Him. Then *He* gives us rest. We find rest in a person, not in a method. Go to Jesus in prayer. Give Him your burdens. Allow Him to teach you. Because His yoke is light, consider whether you are putting burdens on yourself that He never asked you to assume. Pray about what He wants you to do and be faithful with that."

Oh no, here comes that challenging season of Lent with the disciplines of prayer, fasting, and alms-giving; lots of WORK and not much fun! Actually, Lent is a journey back to God, answering the call of the prophet Joel, "Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love" (2:13). Fasting is not simply a giving up of favorite foods or pastimes, but a call to a re-orientation of our lives. Are there ways in which we regularly use our time, talent and financial resources that feel good for a moment, but hurt us long-term? Is the Lord calling us to leave some harmful habits behind and to move into more life-giving ways of growing in love for Him and our neighbors? Are we called to let go of heavy worries and grudges to experience freedom in the forgiveness and mercy of Jesus and to extend that grace to others? Maybe the 40-day journey of Lent is not burdensome, but about Jesus lifting the burdens from us. That is truly joyful Good News!

Enclosed in this mailing and available at Zion is a devotional booklet to encourage prayer throughout the season of Lent. May we hear how Jesus calls each of us to live in the Joy of Salvation in our individual lives and as together as His body, the Church, every day.

#### YouTube Broadcast Worship

In addition to continuing to worship with Zoom, congregants and visitors to join in Worship on Sundays and Wednesdays on YouTube. We broadcast worship on our YouTube channel using YouTube Live. The content of worship will be the same as attending via Zoom, however YouTube offers some differences, including:

- Anonymity Watching the worship service through YouTube is a similar experience to watching a video on your computer. Unlike participating via Zoom, there is no way for us to see or hear you during the service. Joining Worship this way is completely anonymous.
- More accessible Many devices such as Smart TVs and DVD players, Roku, tablets, and some cable boxes now come with the YouTube app built in. Just look for the YouTube Logo on your device.

How to join via YouTube: At worship time, open the YouTube app or go to <u>youtube.com</u>. Search for Zion Lutheran Church Harrisburg & select the result with a photo of the church as the icon. On our main page will be an alert that we are "Live," allowing you to join. We will start broadcasting 5 to 10 minutes before worship starts.
